1. PACRA Registration

- In order to apply as a cooperative society, the applicant must get in touch with PACRA and provide all the necessary documents, which include:
 - Co-operative by-laws of constitution of the cooperative society
 - Completed application for registration.
 - Minutes of the meeting in which it was agreed to form a cooperative
 - List of members with their address, paid-up shares, National Registration Cards (NRC)
 - Letter from the district cooperative office.

After acquiring a certificate from PACRA, the applicant must subsequently furnish the following information to ZFCM:

2. For Cooperative Society Data:

- Cooperative Society Name,
- Full Address,
- Certificate Number,
- List of Board Members,
- Society purpose, business or common goal.
- Assets i.e., physical building (by type, Residential, commercial etc.) Land (size, access to water, electricity, cleared/virgin).
- Contact details.

3. Society Member Data including:

- Member Name,
- Full Address,
- ID Number,
- Occupation or skills,
- Assets i.e., physical building (by type, Residential, commercial etc.) Land (size, access to water, electricity, cleared/ virgin)
- Annual Income,
- Source of income/wealth,
- Contact details.
